### **500,000 On Board Units for Australia: Kapsch TrafficCom AG achieves further success in Australia by securing new order**

This order underscores not only the global technological leadership of Kapsch in this field, but also consolidates its position as the clear market leader in Australia with a market share of well over 80%.**

The client, Transurban, operates five of the nine urban motorways in Sydney as well as the privately financed toll system of CityLink in Melbourne. The term of the current contract is 2 years (including an option to extend and/or increase the order volume).
