
The Kapsch CarrierCom Visitor's Guide provides you with all the information needed for your next journey to our premises. To make your time in Vienna as convenient as possible, it contains information about our location, your arrival and departure, accommodation possibilities, such as other important facts about your stay.

1 Where are we located?

Kapsch CarrierCom is headquartered in Vienna (Austria) inside the **EURO PLAZA**, which is the largest and most successful office park of its kind today.

> **By train**
The Schnellbahn (S-Bahn) is a low-priced way of getting from Vienna to the airport and back.
From the airport please take the S7 train to the station "Wien Rennweg" and then change to the S2 train to "Wien Meidling". Please take exit "Schedifkplatz".

Duration: ca. 40 minutes

Costs: One-Way-Ticket EUR 2,40

Alternatively, you can take the IC 549 train (direct connection; no need to change trains) to the station "Wien Meidling". In "Wien Meidling" please take the exit "Schedifkplatz".

Note: This trains runs every 30 minutes.

Duration: ca. 30 minutes

Costs: One-Way-Ticket: EUR 4,40

> **By taxi**
Use taxi & limousine services at the airport for added convenience and flexibility.

Costs: ca. EUR 25,00 – 45,00

Duration: ca. 30 minutes

> **By car**
To enable you to travel freely without being reliant on public transport, you can rent a car with the car rental companies at the airport. You can find more information on www.viennaairport.com/carrental.

If you want to go back to the airport and you have a GPS navigation, you can use the following data to find it:

1.1 Directions.

1.1.1 Airport transport.

To get from and to the airport you have the following possibilities:

- > **By City Airport Train / CAT**
The CAT takes just 16 minutes nonstop to get from central Vienna (Wien Mitte) to the airport and vice versa. The City Airport Train operates daily from 05.36 a.m. to 23.36 p.m.
Costs: One-Way-Ticket: EUR 11,00; Return-Ticket: EUR 17,00
Duration: ca. 16 minutes
From "Wien Mitte" please take the S1 train to "Wien Meidling".
Costs: One-Way-Ticket: EUR 2,20
Duration: ca. 15 minutes

1.1.2 Access to Kapsch CarrierCom by car.

EURO PLAZA is convenient and quick to reach. Exits for the A1 and S1 highways are located in the immediate vicinity, making the Kapsch CarrierCom accessible from the Vienna-Schwechat Airport in only 20 minutes and from the city center in only 15 minutes.


If you have a GPS navigation, you can use the following data to find it:

Street: Lehrbachgasse 11

Postcode: 1120, Town: Vienna

Parking: The office park offers ample parking. As a Kapsch CarrierCom visitor please use parking garage G (yellow parking sign in the picture on your right) in building G. The entrance is near the Nestle/Nespresso shop.

You can stamp your parking ticket from the reception, but only when you parked the car in parking garage G.



1.1.3 Access to Kapsch CarrierCom by public transport.

The **U6 subway line**, along with regional and international train services, stops nearby and several busses stop close to or directly in front of the main entrance:

- > U6 subway line (stop “Bahnhof Meidling”, take exit “Schedifkplatz”)
- > Commuter trains S1 and S2 (stop “Bahnhof Meidling”, take exit “Schedifkplatz”)
- > Badner Bahn (stop “Schedifkplatz”)
- > 62 tramline (stop “Bahnhof Meidling”)
- > Bus routes 7A, 8A, 9A, 59A, 62A and 63A (stop “Bahnhof Meidling”), 15A (stop “Am Europlatz”)

Public transport tickets: Tickets for using Vienna’s public transport system can be conveniently purchased around the clock. All underground stations have ticket vending machines and one of Vienna’s 850 tobacconists (Tabaktrafik) shops is usually just around the corner.

All of the following can be purchased at a ticket vending machine or tobacconist:

- > Single and 2-trip tickets, regular or reduced fare
- > Strip tickets (Streifenkarten) for four single trips, regular or reduced fare
- > The Vienna Card (Wien Karte)
- > 24, 48 and 72-hour Vienna passes
- > 8-day tickets
- > Weekly and monthly passes

Costs: Single ticket: EUR 2,20

Qando – App: This free app for iOS and Android devices from the Viennese public transport system („Wiener Linien“) is using real-time information and an integrated route-planner, incorporating disruption information and ticketing possibilities, as well as network maps and points of interest (POI). The app is available both in the Apple Store and Google Play Store. If you do not own such a mobile phone you can also use the web version “qando Mobile Web”. The only requirement is a web-enabled device.

1.1.4 Neighbourhood and hotels.

2 Arrival at Kapsch CarrierCom. *Welcome to Kapsch CarrierCom.*

2.1 Reception.

Upon arrival go straight to our reception. The receptionist will ask you to fill out a form for visitors (name, company, contact person at Kapsch CarrierCom). Then you will get a visitor's badge, which you have to wear all the time. Please don't forget to give the badge back when leaving the building. If the reception is not staffed, please interject it into the slot at the reception desk.

The receptionist will call contact person who will then pick you up from the ground floor.

2.2 Baggage.

Do you have baggage with you? That is not a problem – You can leave it at the reception. If you wish to lock your baggage for safety reasons, please note that this is only possible during the times of reception.

There is also the possibility to store the luggage just behind the reception desk, but which is sometimes unobserved and no liability is assumed.

2.3 Cafeteria.

You are probably hungry or thirsty after your trip, so check out our new Cafeteria "Oasis", near the reception desk. The Cafeteria offers different kinds of coffee, tea or non-alcoholic beverages and of course snacks like soup and sandwiches.

3.2.2 **Airport Shuttle Bus.**

You can also use the Airport Shuttle Bus (Bus line 1187), which has its bus stop in "Bahnhof Meidling".

Duration: ca. 40 minutes

Costs: One-Way-Ticket: EUR 8,00

3.2.3 **Train.**

If you prefer the train, please take the S1 or S2 train to the station "Rennweg" and then change to the S7 train to "Flughafen Wien".

Duration: ca. 40 minutes

Costs: One-Way-Ticket: EUR 4,40

Alternatively, you can take the IC 549 train (direct connection; no need to change trains) to the station "Flughafen Wien". This train runs every hour.

Duration: ca. 30 minutes

Costs: One-Way-Ticket: EUR 2,20

5 *Important information about your trip.*

5.1 *Currency and exchange rates.*

As a member of the European Community, Austria is also a member of the economic and currency unions, adopting the Euro as the common currency. For foreign currencies, the appropriate exchange rates apply.

5.2 *Bank hours and A.T.M's.*

Bank Opening Hours (General): Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday from 08:00 to 12:30 and 13:30 to 15:00
Thursday from 08:00 to 12:30 and 13:30 to 17:30

Cash Machines (A.T.M.'s): In addition to the banks themselves, cash withdrawals can be made from one of the 3000 cash machines across the whole of Austria. Generally accepted cards include: Maestro, MasterCard, American Express, Visa and Diners credit cards and Cirrus and Visa-Plus debit cards.

Credit Cards: Credit cards are widely accepted in numerous hotels, restaurants, shops and petrol stations in cities and tourist areas. The logos at the front of the venue (normally on the front door) display the accepted credit cards.

5.4 *Doctors' services, pharmacies.*

Doctors and pharmacies are widely available across Vienna.

Pharmacies are open from Mon-Fri 8-12 and 14-18 (there is often a 24 hour service in Vienna) and Sat 8-12.

Pharmacies have rotating Sunday and evening opening hours, with closed pharmacies displaying the contact details of the nearest open pharmacy.

5.5 *The taste of Austria.*
