

Kapsch TrafficCom technologies have three objectives:

Tolling: The products and solutions of KTC cover the entire spectrum of toll collection services –from multi-lane free-flow traffic on roads and highways, to traditional toll booths and managed lanes, to V2X tolling (North America only). Kapsch provides the entire infrastructure required and supports the operators with the roll-out and commercial operation of the systems with toll controls.

Traffic Management: Traffic solutions for highways, bridges, tunnels, and managed lanes help to lower CO₂ emissions to enable the most efficient use of infrastructure and a cost-effective development. From connected vehicles to smart mobility platforms, KTC is developing the traffic of the future.

Smart Corridor in Gwinnett County, Georgia

Deployment and operation and maintenance of a 400intersection smart corridor turnkey project. Some of the use cases are:

- Emergency Vehicle Preemption (EVP): prioritizing emergency response vehicles for faster, safer travel
- Transit Signal Priority (TSP): reducing delays for public transportation
- **Construction and Maintenance Vehicle Alerts:** enhancing worker safety in active work zones



Largest connected infrastructure project in **Europe with German Autobahn**

Deployment of ITS roadside stations on over 5,300 miles of highways.

- First use case: roadworks warnings
- Further use cases to be implemented
- KTC also supplies the software to manage the roadside stations


